THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHAPLEAU

BY-LAW NO. 2006-12

Being a By-law to prohibit the riding of bicycles on any sidewalk within the Township of Chapleau

WHEREAS the Council of a Municipality is empowered by Section 8 & 9 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, to enable the Council to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and to enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Township of Chapleau enacts as follows:

- 1. That no person shall ride any bicycle on any sidewalk, walkway or pedesterian overpass within the Township of Chapleau unless it be in crossing a sidewalk or walkway.
- 2. Penalty

That every person who contravenes the provisions of this By-law established and passed by the Township, pursuant to the authority contained in the Municipal Act or any other General or specific Act, is guilty of an offence and liable upon conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$5,000.00 exclusive of costs and the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33, as amended, shall apply to the said fine.

3. That By-law No. 468 passed on the 16th day of October 1950 be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.

4. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect on the 5th day of June, 2006.

Read a FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 5th day of June, 2006.
